CPT Allbritton commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the Medical Service Corps from the ROTC at University of Alabama at Birmingham in July 2011 and received her Bachelor's degree in Athletic Training from Samford University in May 2011.

After commissioning, CPT Allbritton served as the Ambulance Platoon Leader at the 129th Medical Company (Area Support) until early 2015 when she was transferred to the 161st Multifunctional Medical Battalion to fulfill the role of Medical Logistics Officer in the Force Health Protection section. CPT Allbritton completed AMEDD Basic Officer Leader Course in May 2012 and currently holds two AOCs as a Medical Operations Officer (70H) and Medical Logistician (70K).

CPT Allbritton deployed as a Medical Operations Officer with the 135th Expeditionary Sustainment Command to Kuwait in support of Operation Spartan Shield (August 2017-April 2018). She then completed a follow-on tour as a Medical Operations Officer with Special Operations Task Force-Afghanistan in support of Operation Freedom Sentinel (April 2018-February 2019).
