

MMI Disc Golf Course Policy

1. Marion Military Institute's 18-hole disc golf course travels the perimeter of MMI's historic college campus. Designed by former PDGA World Champion Tom Monroe, the course offers a challenging round as it meanders through some of the campuses most iconic landmarks. At nearly 5,000 feet long, the course offers both open and technical holes for the beginner and more seasoned player.
2. The MMI Disc Golf Course is open from dusk to dawn, 7 days a week for MMI Cadets, Staff and Faculty. MMI Cadets, Faculty and Staff can sign out discs through the Alumni Gym by leaving an ID card. It is the responsibility of the user to return the discs upon completion of the round. *Lost disks will incur a financial penalty.*
3. Each tee box will be marked with the hole number, distance to basket, par, and a diagram of the hole.
4. Out-of-Bounds. All roads and buildings are considered out-of-bounds. Additionally, the baseball and softball fields along with the tennis courts are also considered out-of-bounds.
5. Safety and Courtesy. Always yield the right of way to runners, walkers and campus employees and cadets. Be very careful when crossing streets. Exercise extreme caution when venturing into the rough as there may be Poison Ivey/Oak, snakes, etc. *Individuals may be held financially liable for any damage they cause to college property.*
6. Always remember safety first and be sure everyone is clear before throwing.

At this time the course is open to the public by invitation only due to liability concerns.
