HOW DO WE RESERVE A DAY?

Starting Tuesday, September 21, 2020, cadets will be able to access an on-line appointment system to schedule a visit with parents/family. Only cadets can schedule the date.

- First open day for visits will be Wednesday.
- Please do not come without a reservation.

WHAT DAYS AND TIMES ARE AVAILABLE?

For the most part, visits can be scheduled for any day of the week between 9am - 5pm. There are a set number of appointments per day, first come, first served.

Some days will be blocked due to academic, athletic or other college requirements.

ARE WE RESTRICTED TO A SET TIME?

No. Your cadet is still responsible for all academic, athletic and cadet requirements during the day, so please ensure that your visit times do not conflict with anything your cadet needs to attend or is responsible for.

WHAT DO WE DO WHEN WE GET TO CAMPUS?

All families are asked to check in at the Guard House as the first step. All visitors are required to enter the Guard House and stand in front of the thermal camera system. The head of family, will then sign in and acknowledge that no visitors have any symptoms of the COVID-19 virus or have recently been in contact with someone who has symptoms or has tested positive. If a visitor has a temperature they will be instructed to leave campus.

TIP: When coming down Washington Street, turn into campus at the big new neon MMI sign (hard to miss). Guard House will be the first building on your right as you get to campus.

Check in. We have tried to make this as simple as possible. There are 4 steps with signs - you do not need to interface with our staff. Only one person needs to fill out the survey (for the group) but we do want all group member's names on the form and everyone to do the temp

WHERE DO WE MEET UP WITH OUR CADET?

Once signed in, you will proceed to Event Parking (by the Softball and Baseball fields, across the street from the Bookstore - where you parked for move-in days). Visitor parking spaces will be marked with orange traffic cones - park in one of these spots and call your cadet to come meet you.

CAN WE LEAVE THE PARKING LOT?

No. Due to our COVID-19 mitigation requirements, all visits must be conducted in the parking lot. Visitors cannot go on campus or in any building. The one exception will be the restrooms located in the Ireland Athletic Center (there will be signs). No tours/wandering around. Please be supportive and understanding that you are meeting with YOUR cadet, but we still have 400 others on campus. We ask you to not wander around outside of the parking lot area as this is the "bubble" our cadets have worked hard to establish and maintain.

What else do we need to know?

- Face Coverings must be worn at all times on campus (except if you bring food and are eating it with your cadet).
- You are asked to maintain social distance from other families and cadets in the designated area.
- You cannot take your cadet off campus.
- You will need to be off campus by 5pm.
- Cadets will be limited to one reservation a week. This may be modified to allow more parents/families the opportunity to visit.
- Unfortunately we do not have facilities for inclement weather.
- Visitors who are not in compliance with these guidelines may be asked to leave. Cadets will be held responsible for the actions/conduct of their guests.
- Please keep in mind that the cadets have worked hard to establish the current safe environment on campus, we expect all our parents and families to respect this and do their best to help us maintain a healthy and safe campus!
- Think about bringing a table and some shade (pop up, beach umbrella). There are grassy areas around the parking lot that will provide a nice space and location. Keep in mind, we have no alternative venues for inclement weather.
